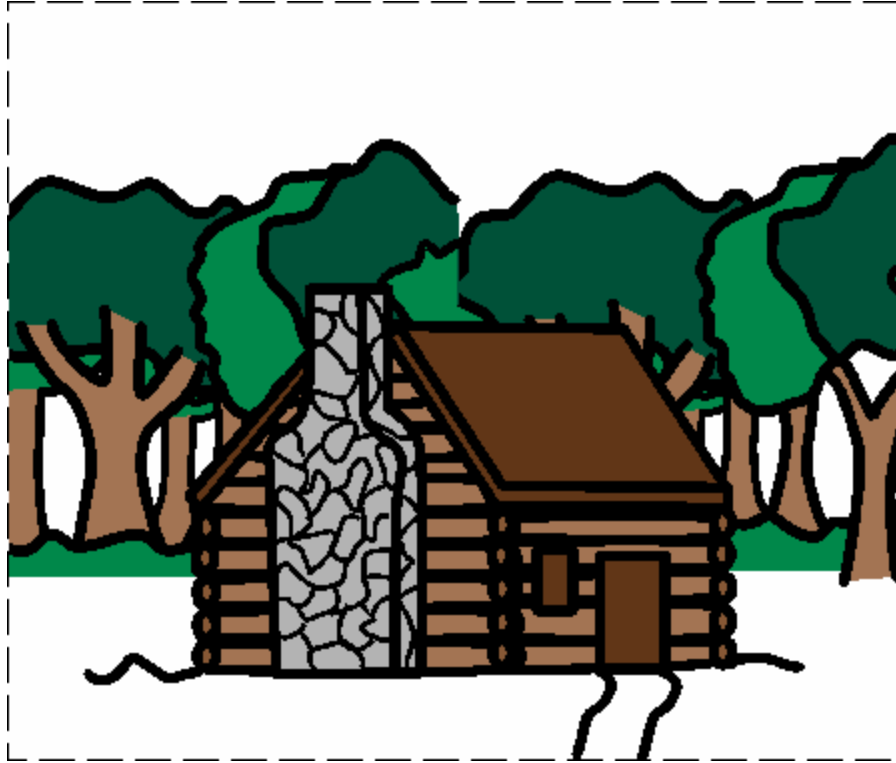
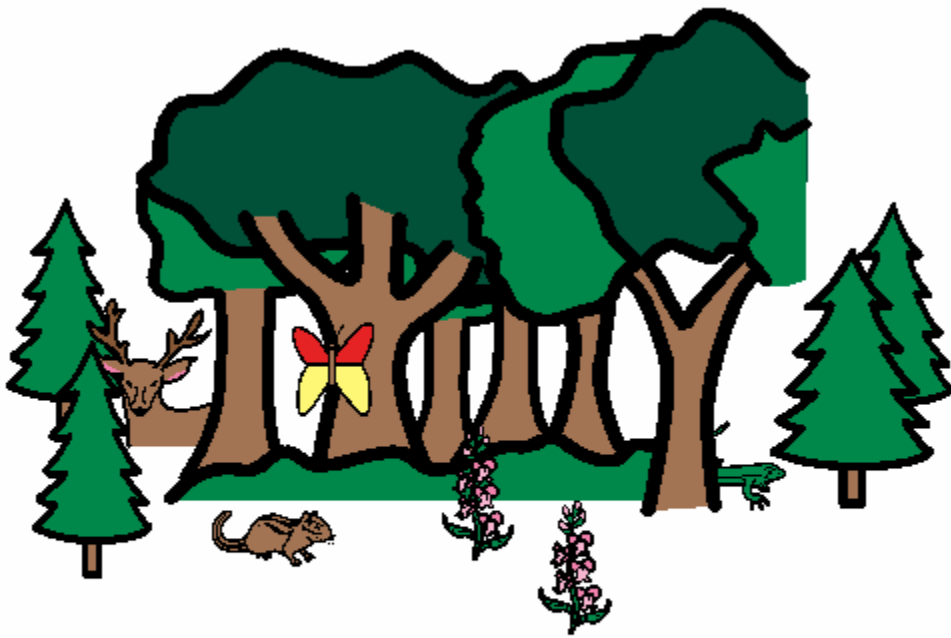


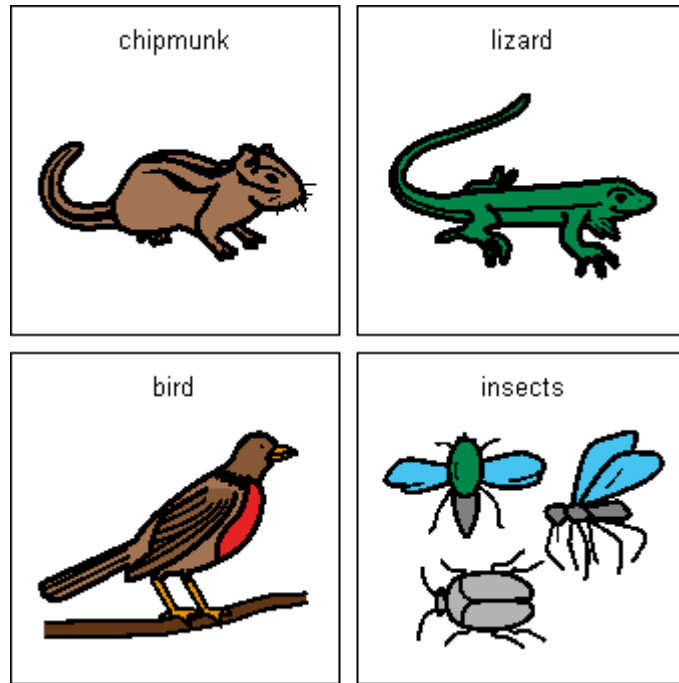
Animals in the Forest



It's fun to be in the woods at Kiwanis Camp.



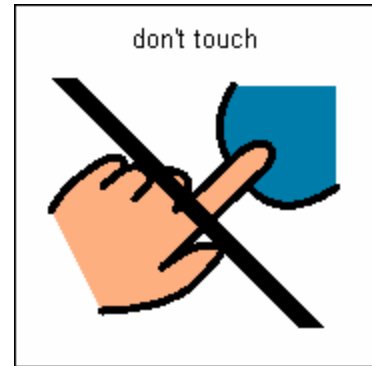
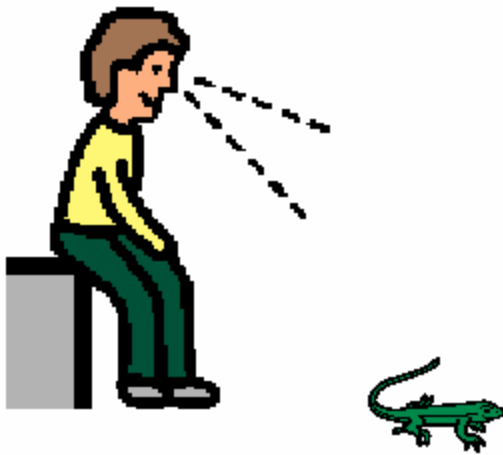
There are lots of animals and plants to see
in the woods.



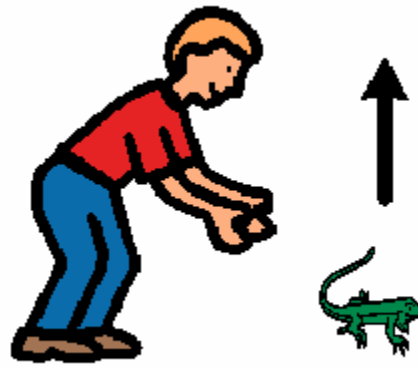
I might see chipmunks, lizards, birds, and insects at camp.

I will try my best not to touch it or pick it up.

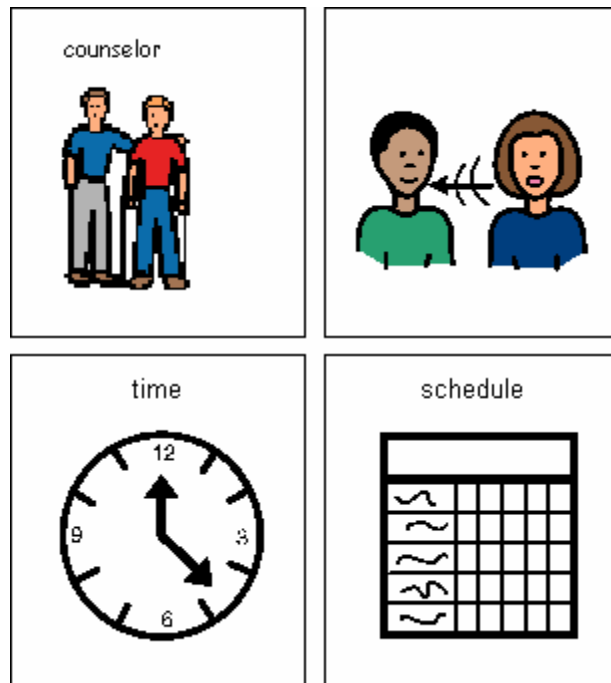


If I pick up a lizard, it might get hurt or feel scared.

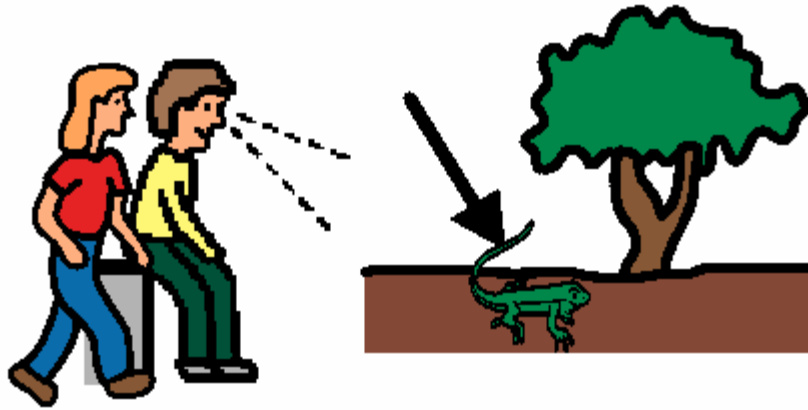


I will let it live in the forest and feel safe.
