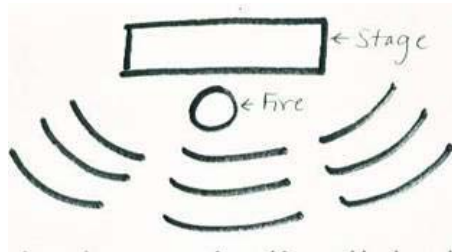
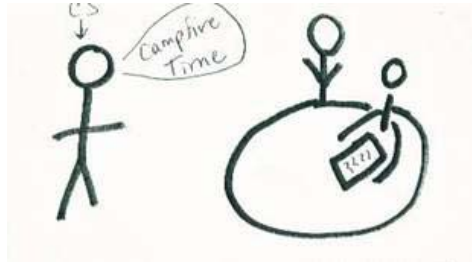


CAMPFIRE



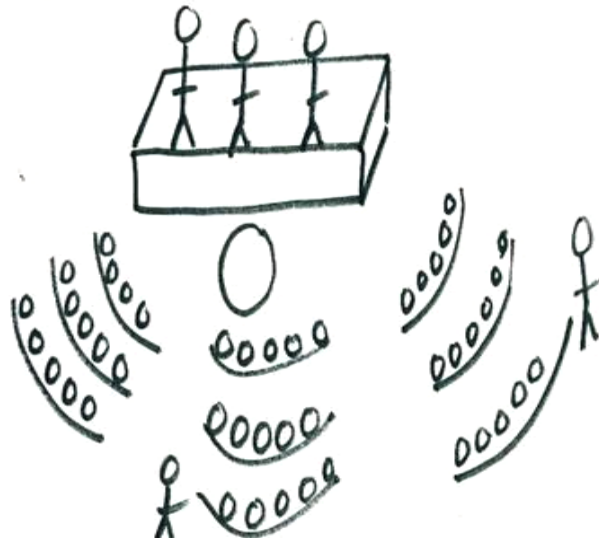
Sometimes after dinner and journal time, everyone will get together for a campfire program. The campfire area has a stage, a place for a campfire, and benches for people to sit on.



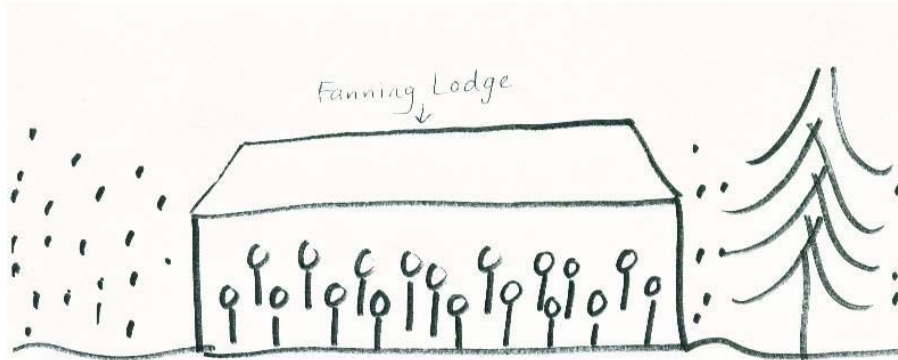

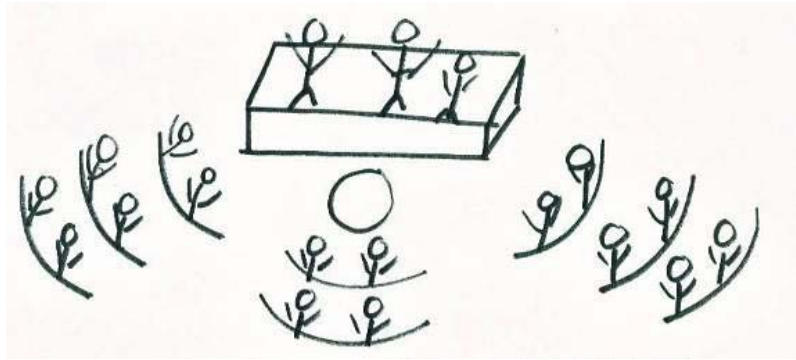
I will walk to the campfire area with my counselor. We will sit with our group. The program staff will build a fire in the fireplace. We will sing camp songs together. I can sing along if I want.



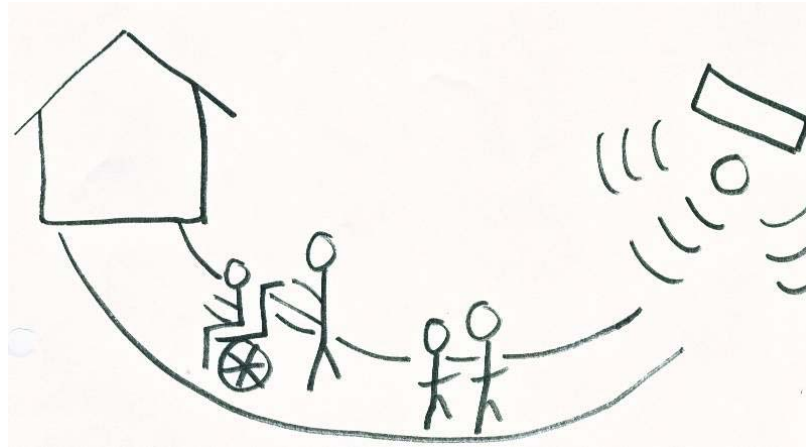
- **Some campers, counselors, or staff may act out a skit or tell a story. I will try to be quiet so everyone can hear the skit or story.**
