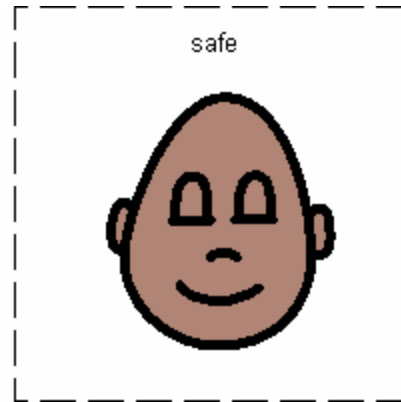
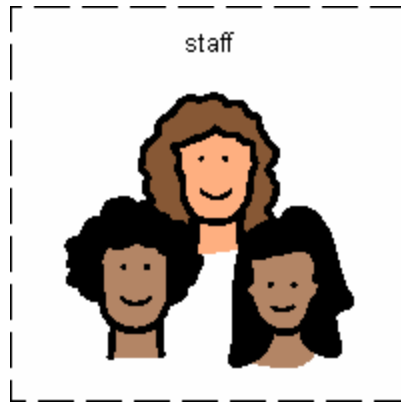
At Kiwanis Camp there are fun activities

whistle

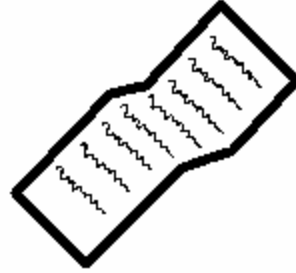


At canoeing we use life jackets to help us stay safe. We have a whistle to call the staff person if we need help.

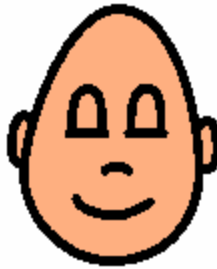

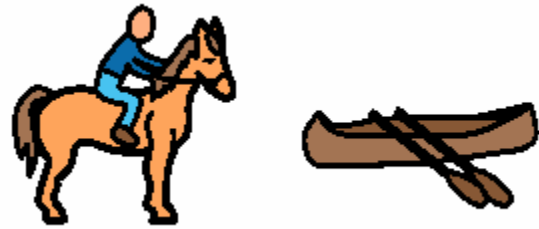
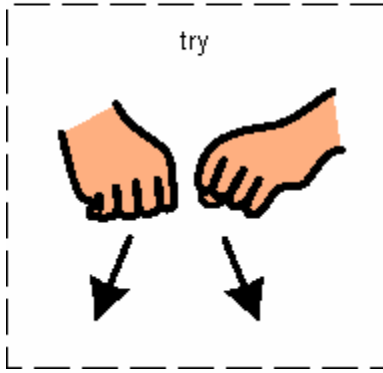
Safety Rules



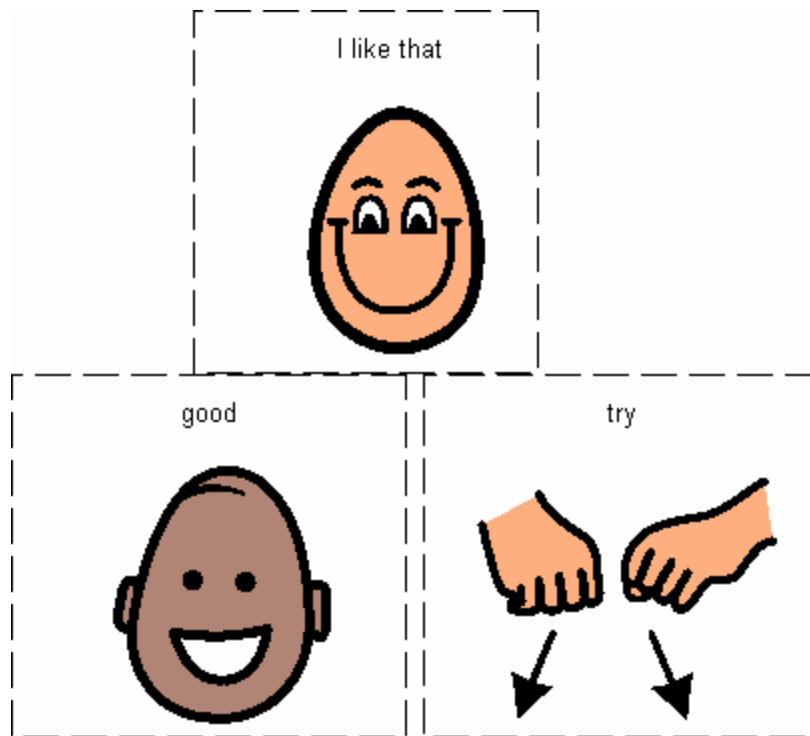

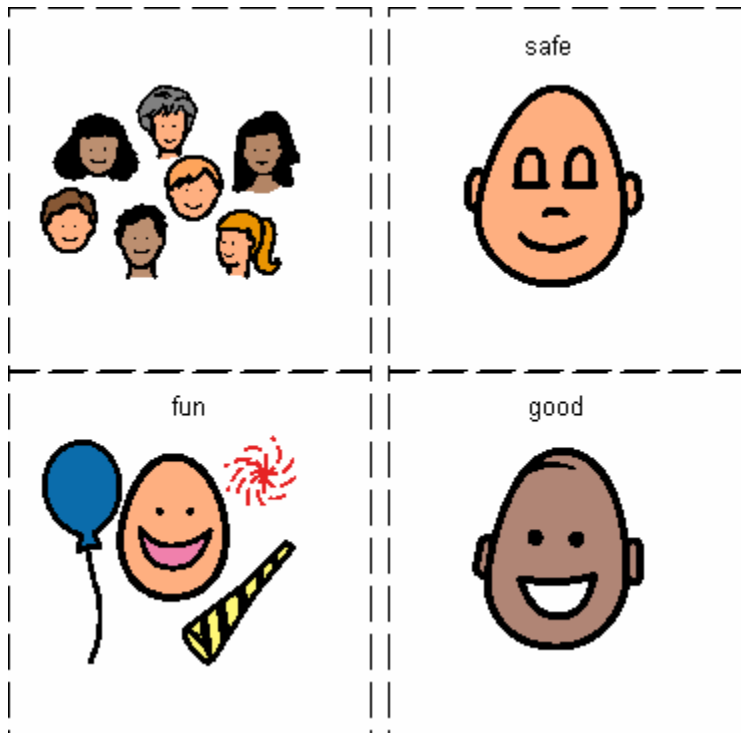
