

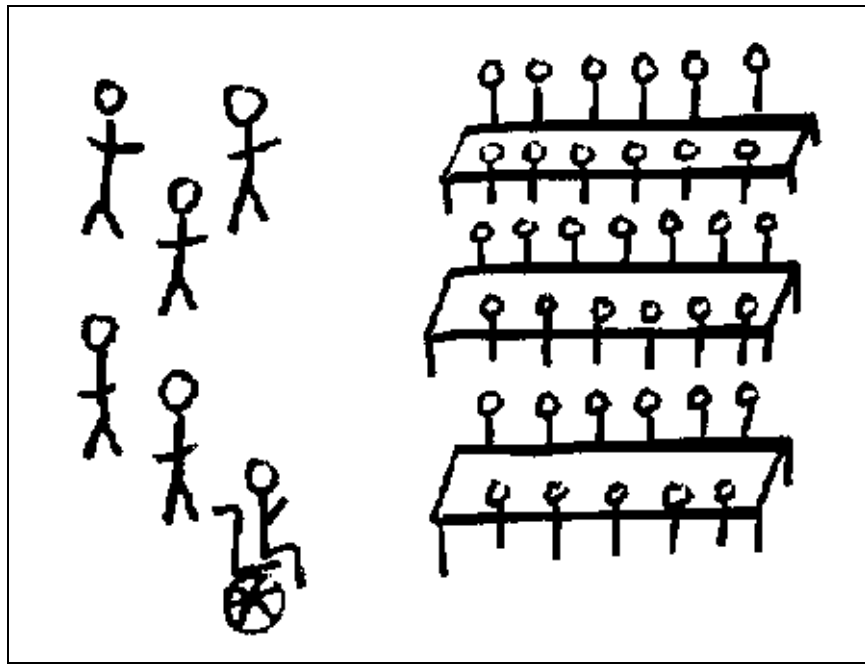
MEALTIME



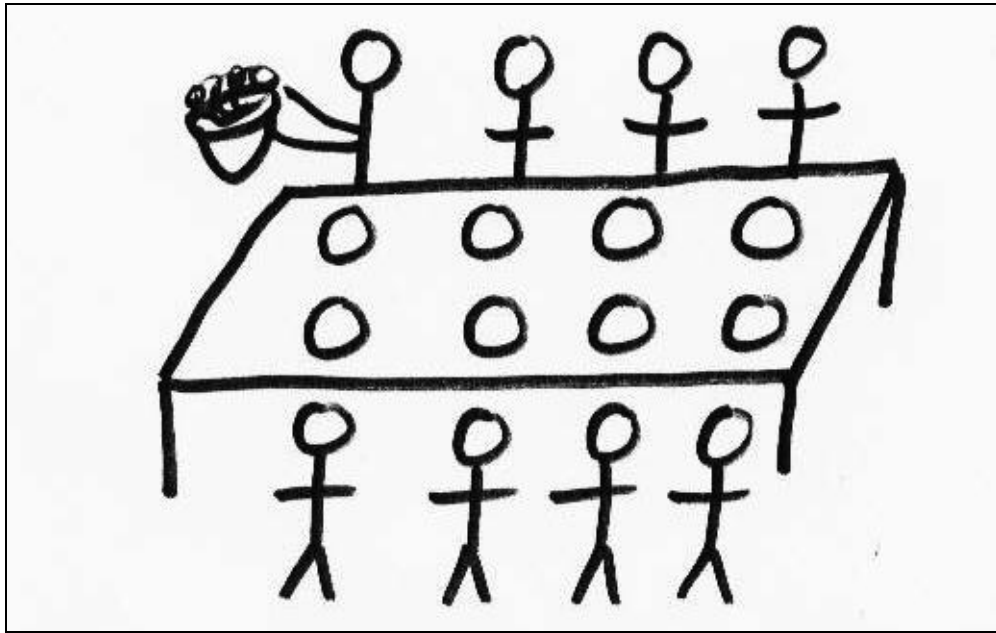
At Kiwanis Camp everyone eats breakfast, lunch, and dinner at Fanning Lodge.



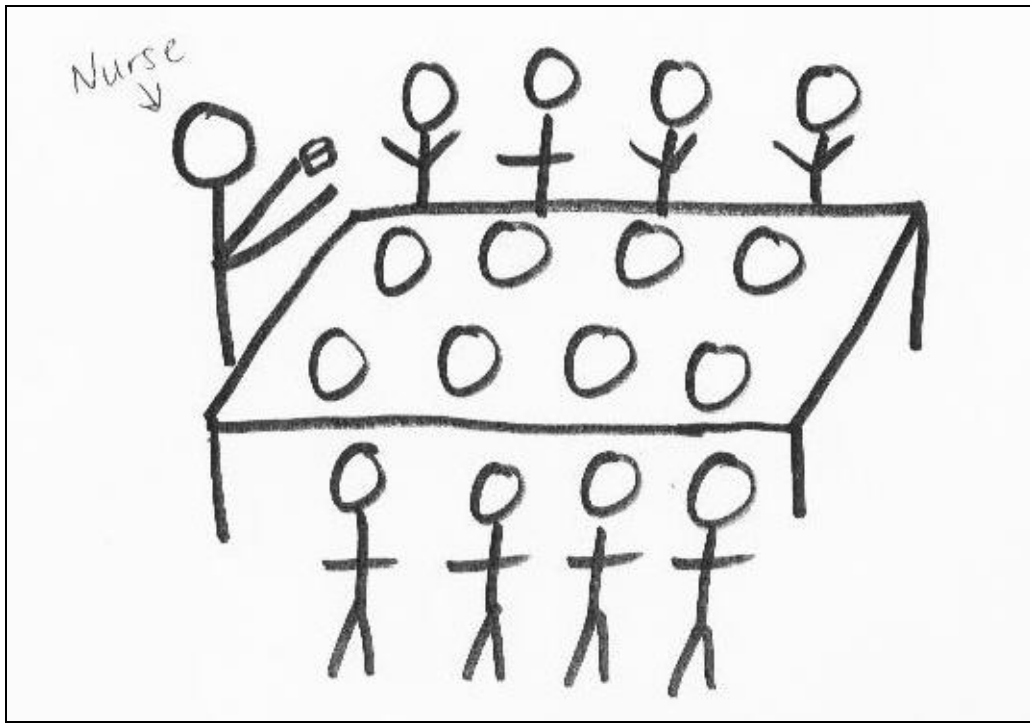
When the meal is ready, someone rings the bell.

My counselor will help me find my group's table. We will sit down. Then everyone will say grace. I will try to listen to the grace.



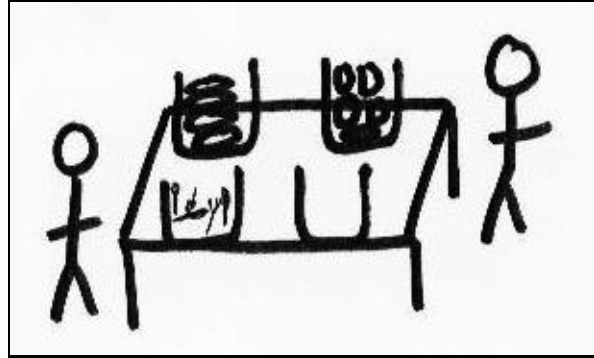
