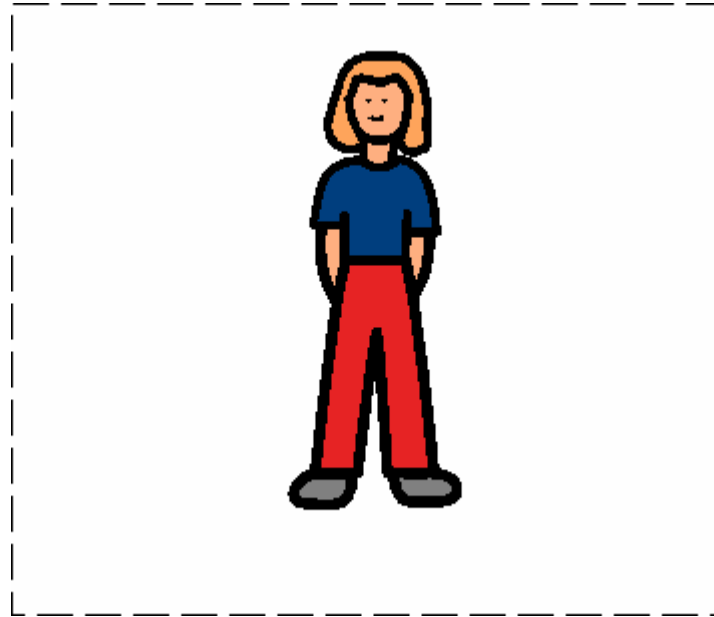


Respecting Personal Space at Camp

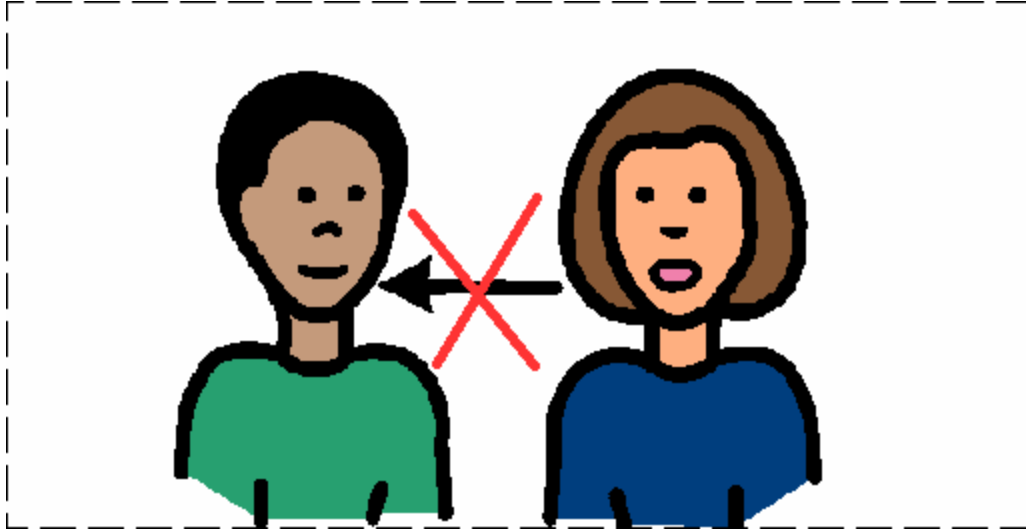

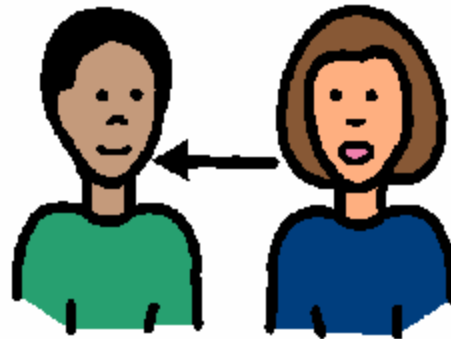


It is fun to be at camp. We do fun things
and make friends.

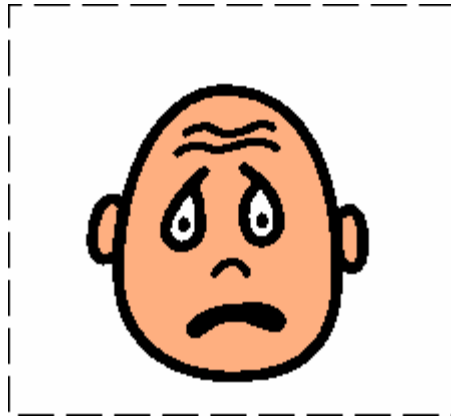


I can make friends when I respect their personal space. That means I will try to not get too close.

If I get too close...

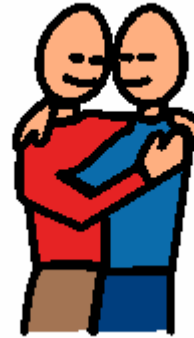


then the other person
might feel uncomfortable.



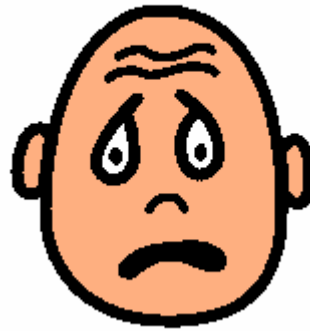
If I hug someone I
don't know very well...

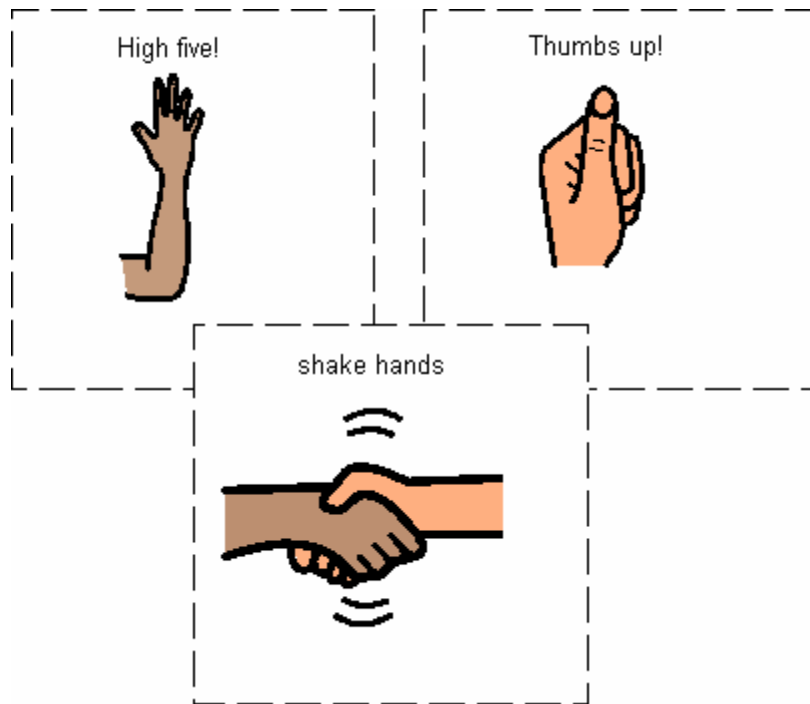
hug

worried



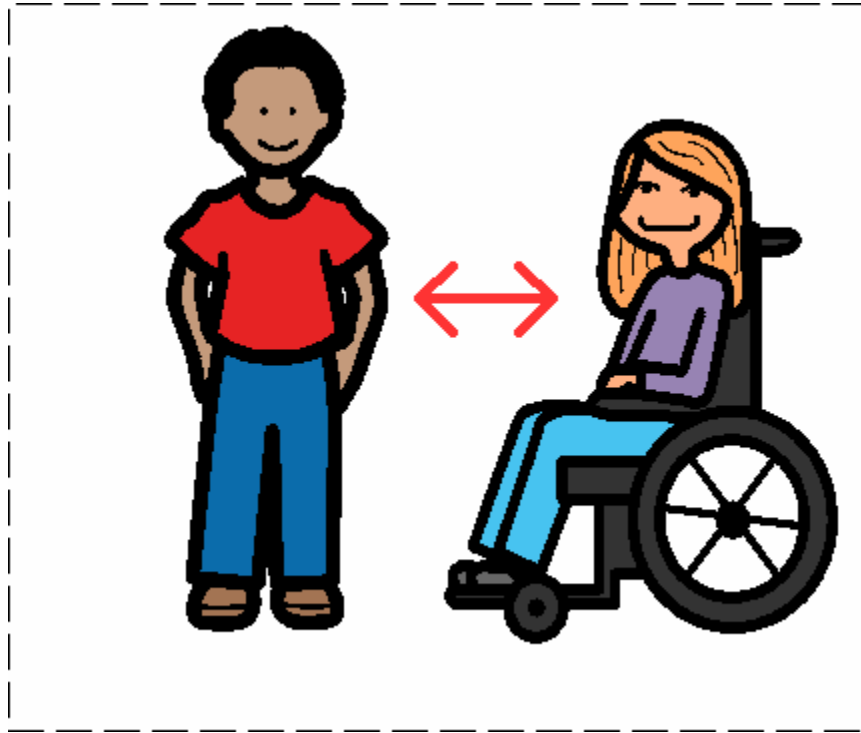


There are other ways I can show people I want to be friends. I can give high-five, thumbs up, or a hand shake.

Good job!

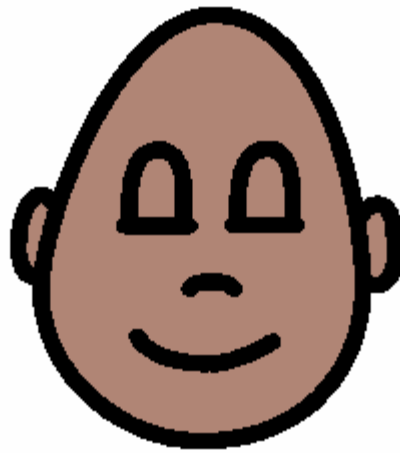


I can say, "Good job!" or, "Nice work!"

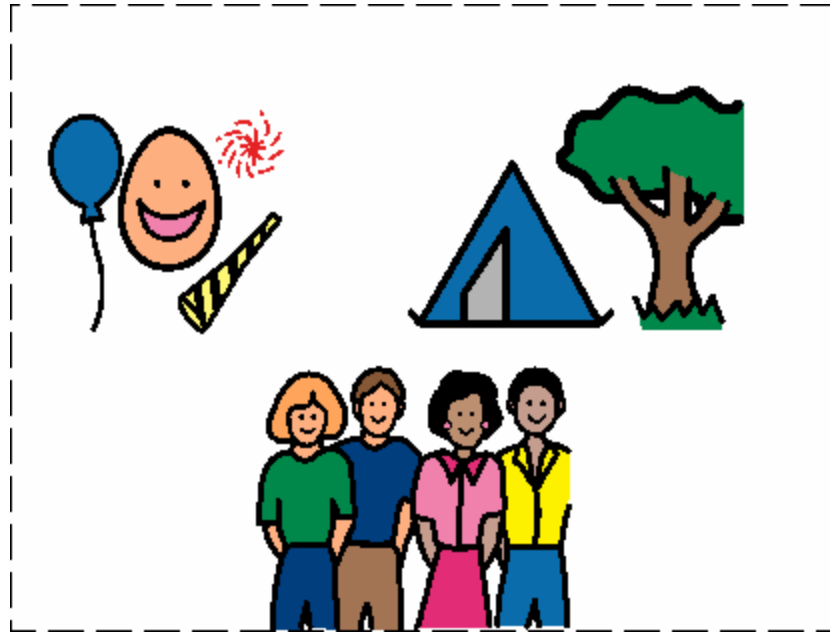


I will try to be respectful at camp.
