

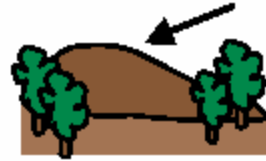
Rocks Stay on the Ground



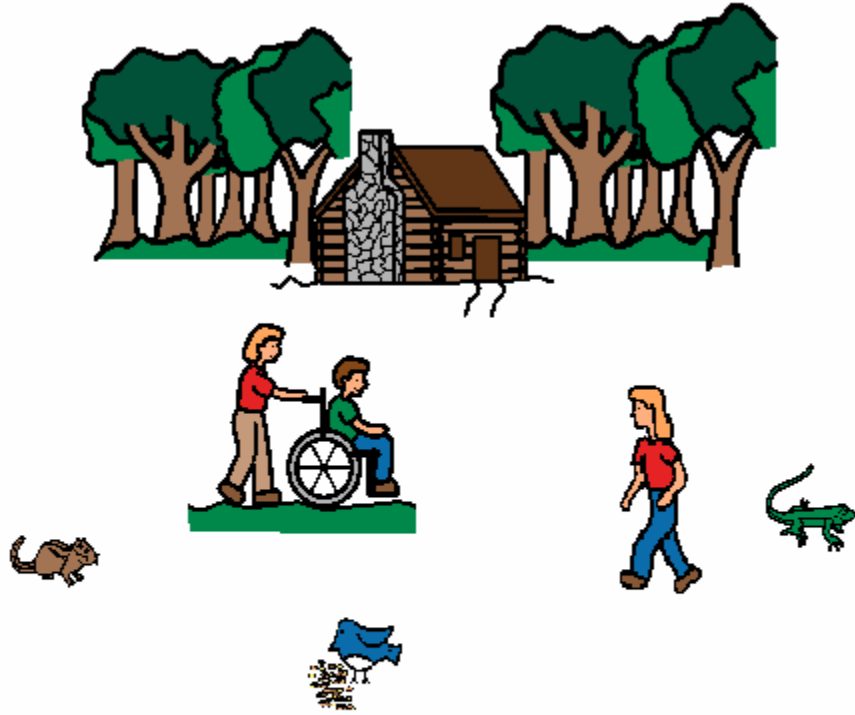
It's fun to be in the woods at Kiwanis Camp.



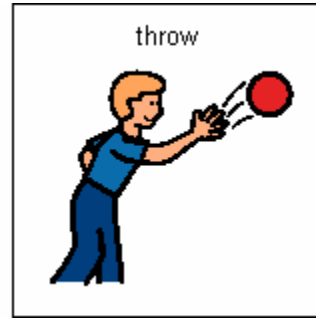
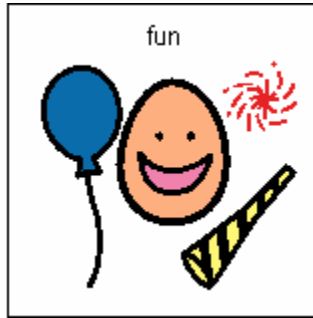
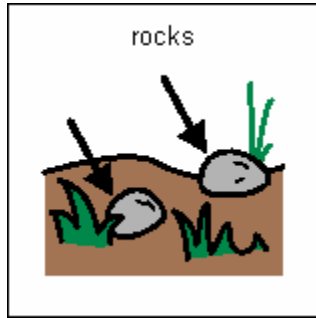
There are lots of fun things to see and do.



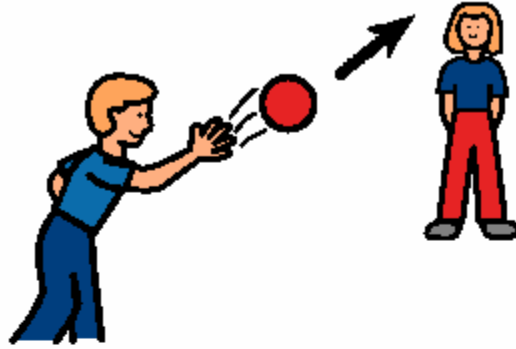
There are trees, rocks, sticks, hills, a pond,
and a river.



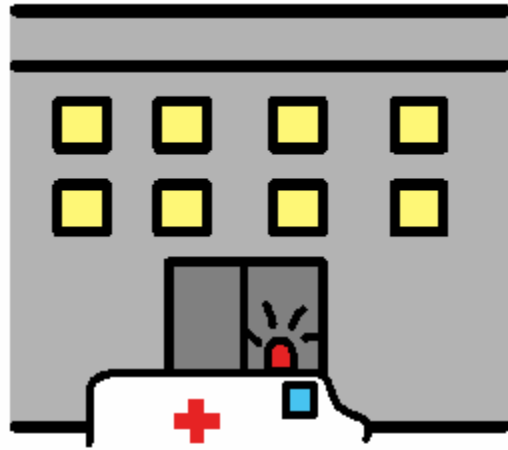
There are animals and people all around the camp.



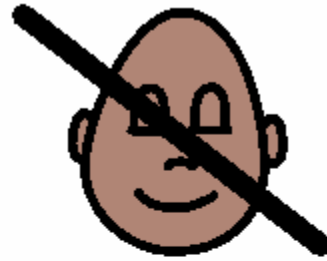
Rocks are fun to throw, but they can be dangerous.



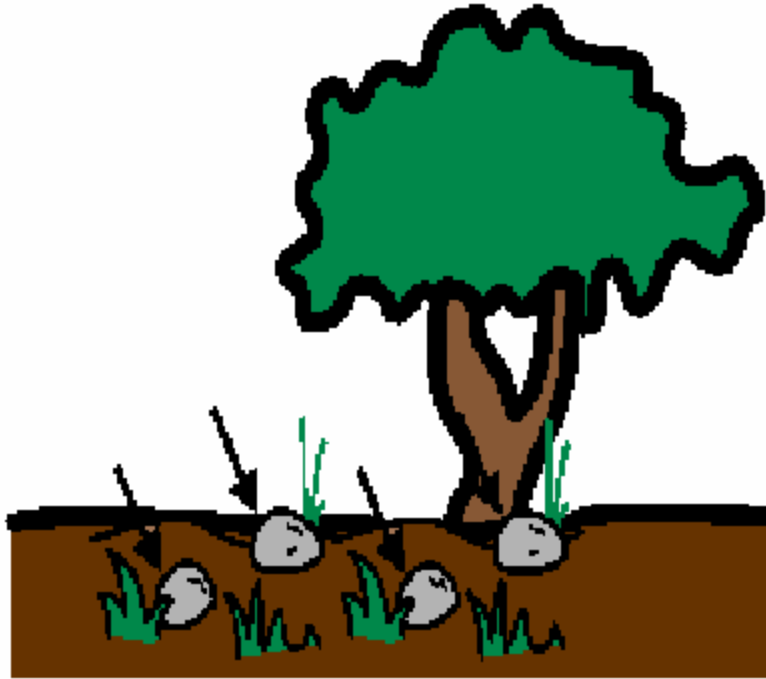
If an animal or person gets hit with a rock,
it really hurts a lot.



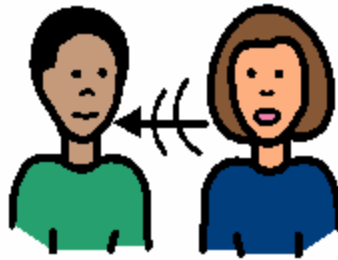
It can hurt a person so much that they might have to go to the hospital.

on the ground.



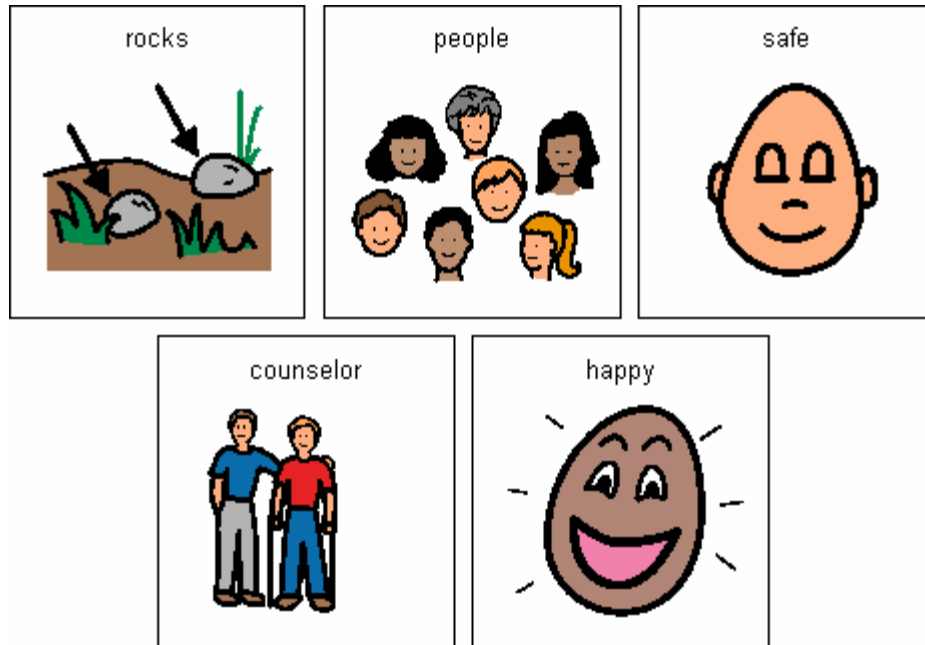
My counselor might say that we can go throw rocks sometime later, at a place where no other people are. That way no one will get hurt.
