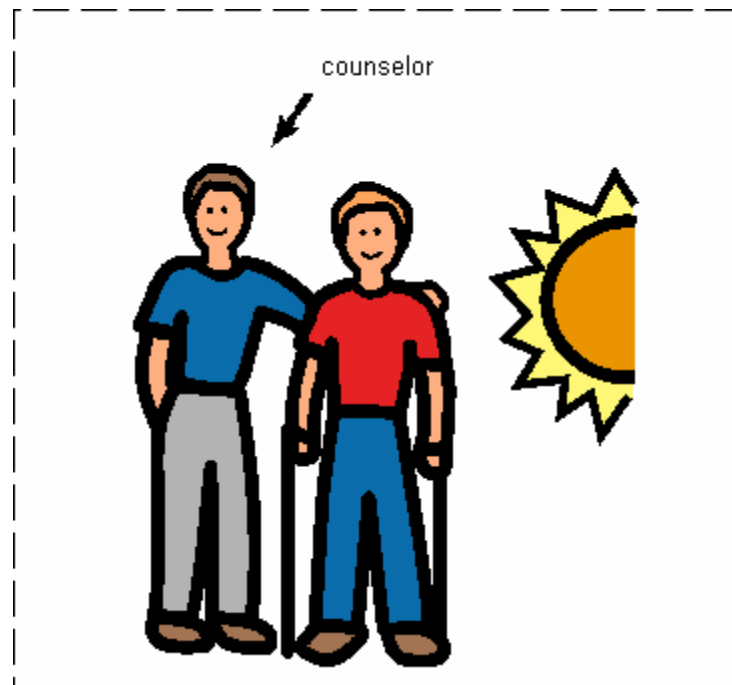


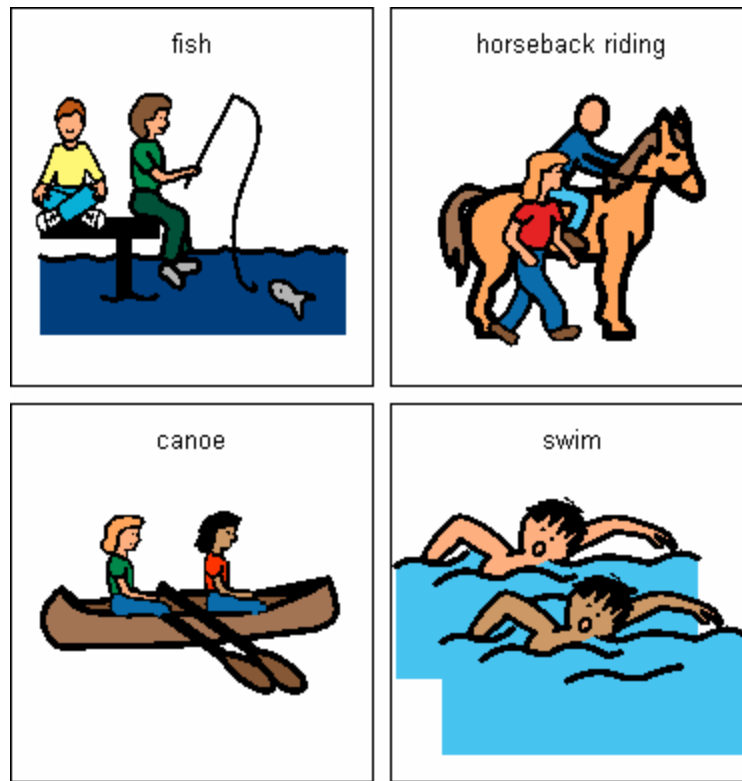

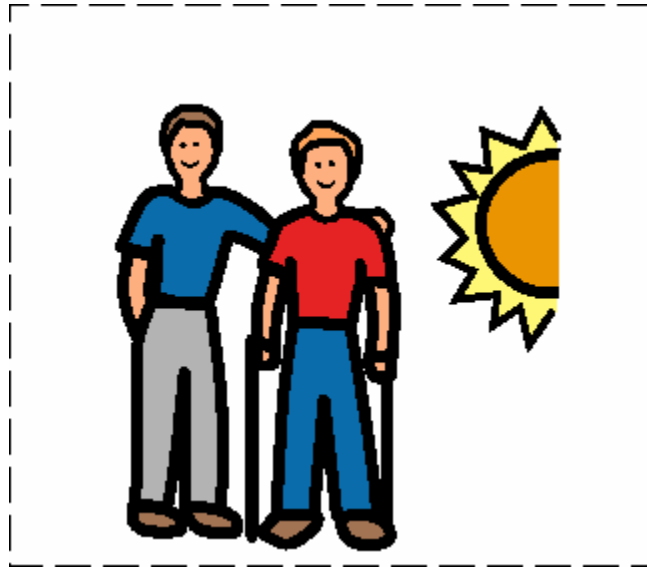
It is fun to be at camp. We can make new friends and do fun things in the outdoors.



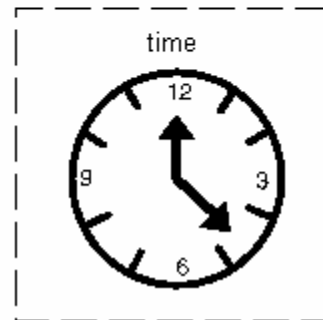
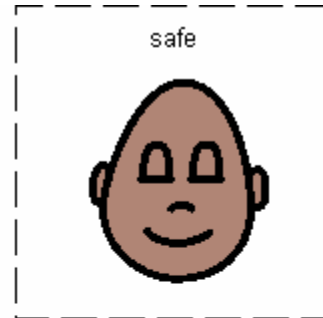
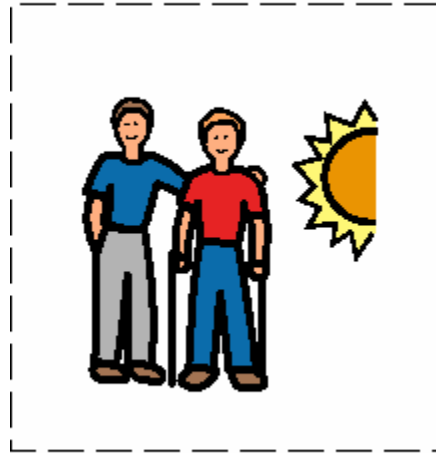
Every camper that comes to Kiwanis Camp has a special new friend. That friend is their counselor.



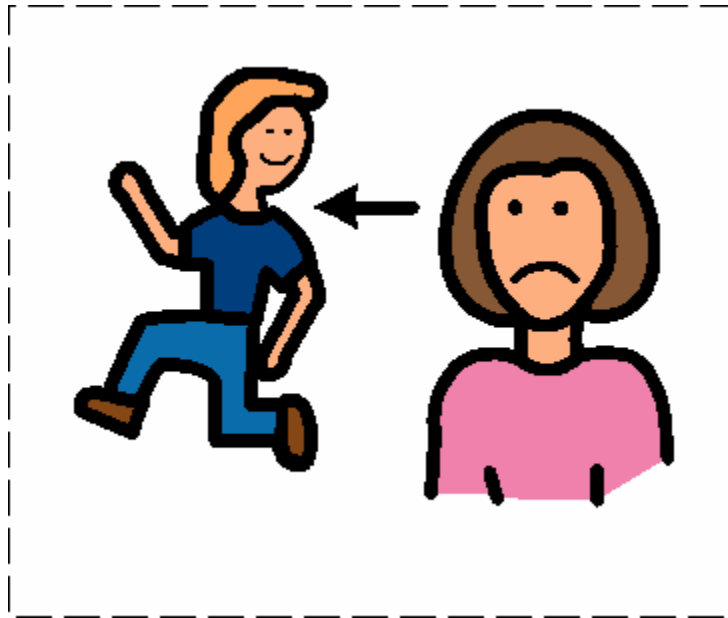
Counselors and campers have fun doing things together at camp.



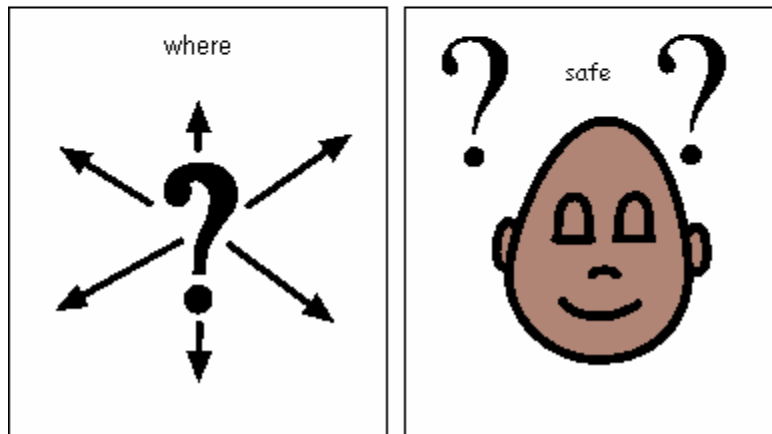
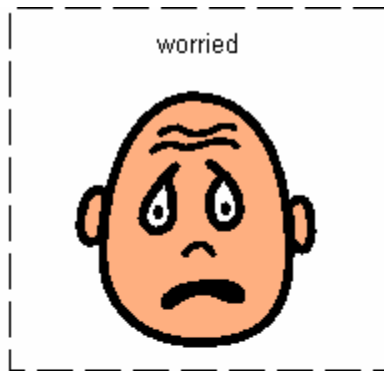

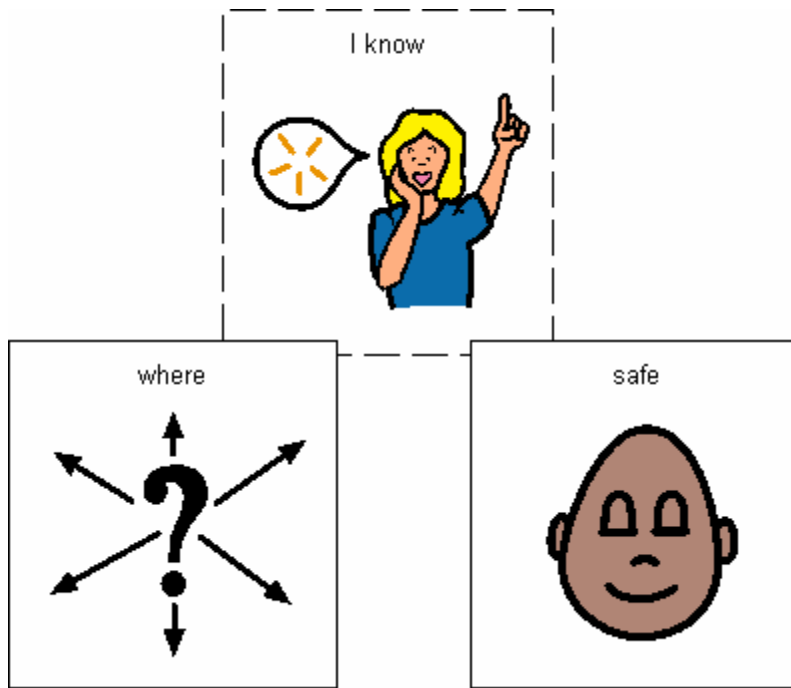
If my counselor needs a break, he or she may say that I will stay with another counselor or staff person at camp.
