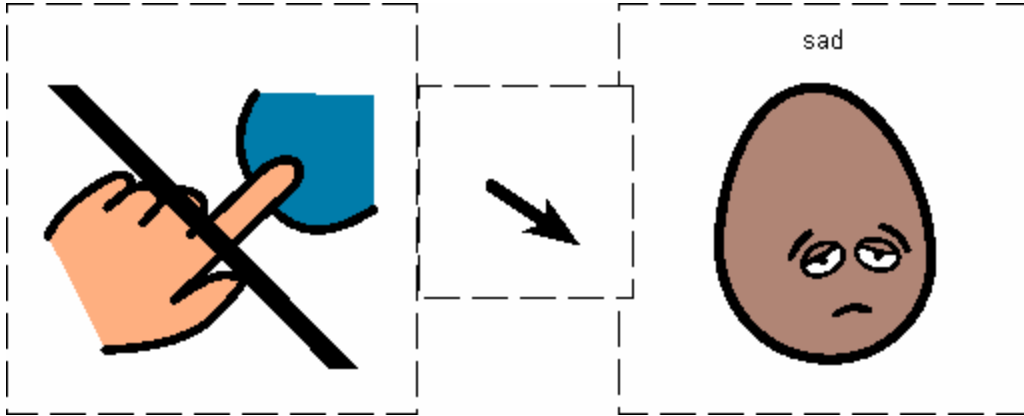
It is fun to be with other people at camp.



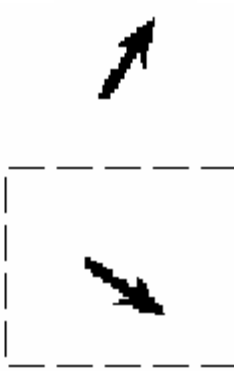
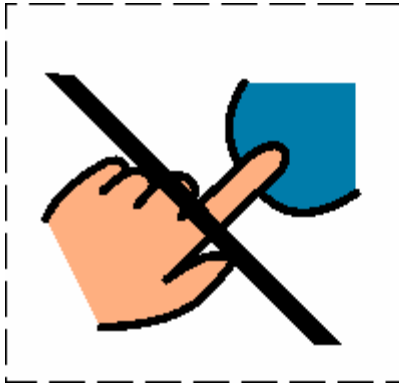

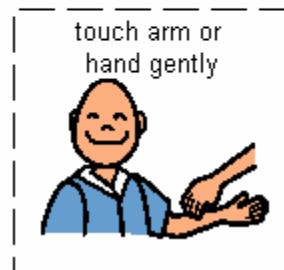
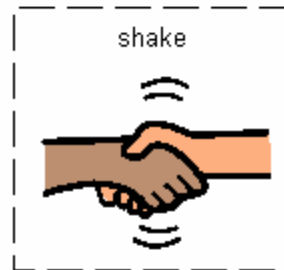
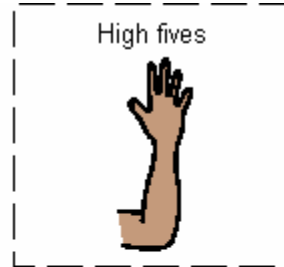
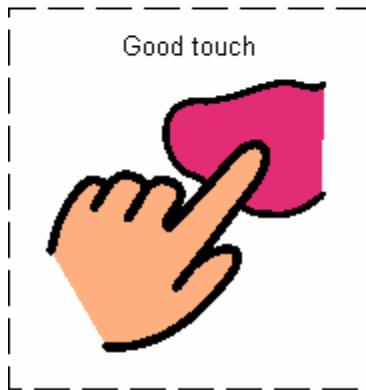
When I touch people the wrong way, it
can make them feel sad.



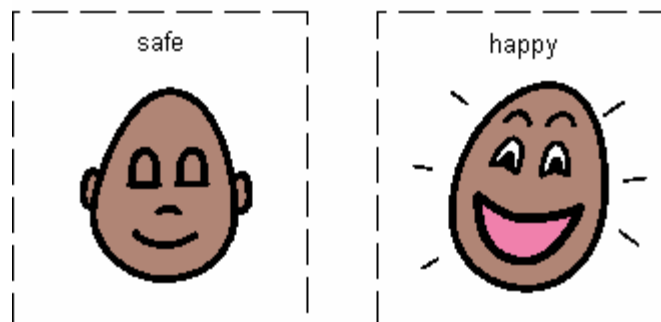
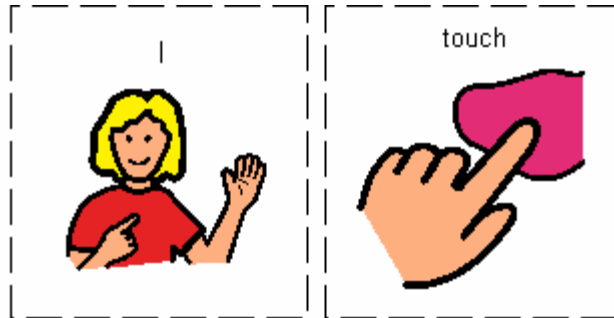
Touching in the wrong way can hurt people's feelings or make them feel mad.



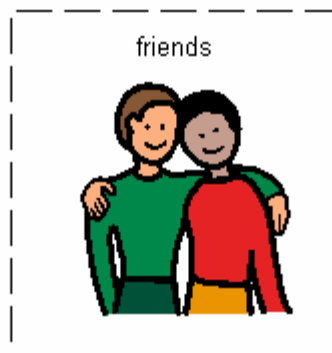
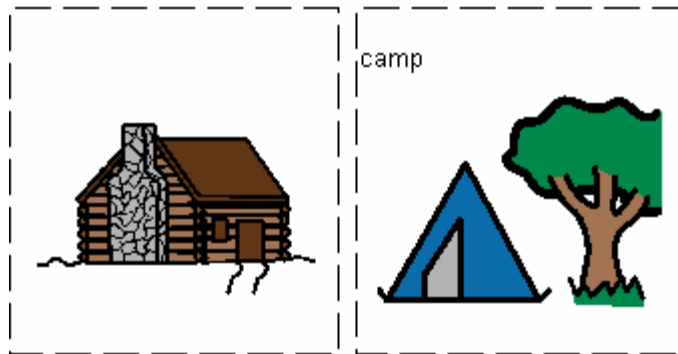
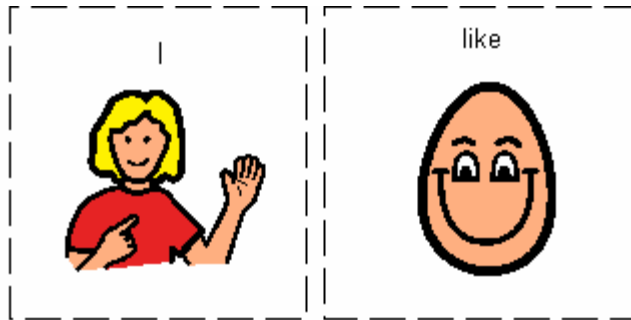
Touching the right way means not touching their body in places that are private.
